*Background:*

Journal writing can be a natural outlet for self-expression. While diaries contain a description of daily events, journals contain not only descriptions but also reflections on what took place and expresses emotions and understanding about it.

It can benefit students and teachers by enhancing reflection, facilitating critical thoughts, expressing feelings and writing more focused points of view.

Helen Keller who wrote her journals between 1936-1937 and proved that writing liberates! She once wrote this insight: "I can see, and that is why I can be happy, in what you call the dark, but which to me is golden."
